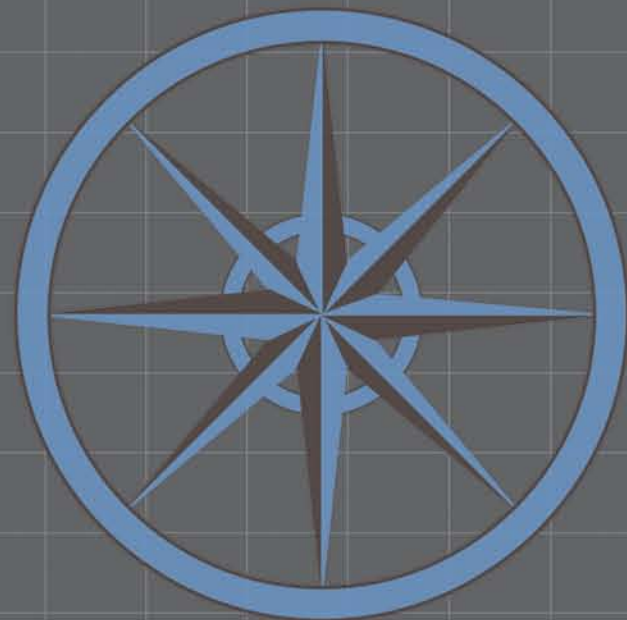


2010 SHORT-TERM MISSION OPPORTUNITIES

JANUARY 29-31

GREAT COMMISSION CONFERENCE

We will host other Central Kentucky churches by providing information & inspiration for them to be more focused on fulfilling The Great Commission.

MARCH 14-23

IRAQ PARTNERSHIP TEAM

COST: \$2,200

A team of 6-8 adults will sow the Gospel with tract distribution in public parks, teach & preach in local house churches. This is in conjunction with our partners in Irbil. Team Leader: Jon Canler

MARCH 29-APRIL 3

NEW YORK PARTNERSHIP TEAM

COST: \$500

Graffiti Church has launched a new church plant in South Bronx & we will provide a team to assist them with a pre-Easter community block party outreach.

MAY 25-JUNE 11

PERU PARTNERSHIP TEAMS

1) SUMMER MISSION TEAM (MAY 25-JUNE 1)

COST: \$600

A team of three college students will do orientation & then acclimate themselves to the Acari River Valley to plant new house churches among the Ayacucho Quechua people through July 31.

2) CHURCH PLANTING SUPPORT TEAM (JUNE 1-11)

COST: \$1,500

A team of five adults will conduct in-home Bible Study groups and Backyard Bible Club evangelism events in support of the Summer Mission Team to help get new churches started in towns of Bella Union, Acari, and Otopara.

JUNE 2-7

KNOXVILLE TEAM

COST \$150

Senior adults will head up this work with Teen Challenge in inner-city Knoxville with door-to-door visitation & evangelistic outreach events. Team Leader: Bob Justus

JUNE 28-JULY 2

DOWNTOWN YOUTH SPORTS EVANGELISM CAMPS

A team will do sports evangelism camps with inner-city kids, ages 5-14, at the Dunbar Community Center.

JULY 10-16

BALTIMORE PARTNERSHIP TEAM

COST: \$350

Two teams will work with Hazelwood Baptist Church; #1) A student team will do Sports Evangelism, #2) A family team to help with VBS.

JULY (1 WEEK, DATE TBA)

NEW ORLEANS TEAM

COST \$150

A cooking/construction team will help rebuild homes in conjunction with Operation NOAH Rebuild, in partnership with the Baptist Association of New Orleans. Team Leader: Alan Owens

POTENTIAL NEW PARTNERSHIP

AUGUST (2 WKS, DATE TBA)

TANZANIA, AFRICA TEAM

COST: \$2,800

A team will assist IMB missionaries in evangelism projects as the beginning of a potential partnership offering high school seniors priority for participation (along with appropriate adult leadership) as a challenge to sacrificial service in missions for the glory of God.

UKRAINE PARTNERSHIP TEAM

COST: \$2,200

A team will assist a Ukrainian church planter, in partnership with Joel & Mary Ellen Ragains, IMB missionaries, assisting with VBS, medical clinic, or other evangelism projects as needed.

AUGUST 14-15

SERVANT EVANGELISM BLITZ/MINISTRY FAIR

Saturday will be our fourth annual event in which Life Bible Study classes go out for a day of service projects in Lexington & Nicholasville. **Sunday** will be our annual Ministry Fair where all members will have opportunity to volunteer for one of our vital 2010 ministry service teams.

SEPTEMBER (10 DAYS, DATE TBA)

PERU TEAM

COST: \$1,500

Church planting team will lead Bible Studies in newly formed house churches in the Acari River valley of southern Peru.

SEPTEMBER (1 WEEK)

BALTIMORE PARTNERSHIP TEAM

COST \$500

In partnership with Hazelwood Baptist Church, a team will be sent to mentor and model door-to-door outreach visits with the members of the church.

POTENTIAL NEW PARTNERSHIP

DECEMBER (10 DAYS)

VIETNAM TEAM

COST \$2,100

Working with 2nd Mission, college students will go to Ho Chi Minh City to do evangelism among students on university campuses.
