What Does the Bible Say about God as Judge?

- God is _____ to be judge. He is owner, creator, Lord, and is holy in all His ways. (Ps. 89:14; 1 Pet. 1:17)
- God is perfectly _____. He judges without compromising His righteousness and without partiality. (Deut. 32:4; 2 Chr. 19:7; Job 34:12; Ps. 9:8)
- God _____ and will judge unrighteous deeds. (Ps. 5:5, 11:5; Prov. 8:13; Rom. 2:1-5, 3:23)
- God judges sin, _____ all things, and completely makes things right at the end time. (Rom. 12:19; Rev. 20:1-15)
- God judges perfectly but on His _____.
- God judges _____ after their earthly life comes to an end. (Ps. 96:13; Rom. 14:10-12; 1 Cor. 3:11-15; 2 Cor. 5:10; 2 Tim. 4:8; Heb. 9:27; Rev. 20:11-15)
- God judges against His standard of _____. (Rom. 3:23, 6:23) In order for someone to have eternity in heaven and a relationship with God, a person must have their sin addressed by Jesus. Without faith in Jesus, God's wrath is shown to those who have not believed. (John 3:36; Rev. 20:15) This judgment is irreversible after death.

- God also judges the follower of Christ but not according to His standard of sinlessness. We are judged according to our _____ as a follower of Jesus. (Matt. 25:14-30; 1 Peter 4:10; 1 Cor. 3:11-15; 2 Cor. 5:10; Rom. 14:10-12)

How Should This Impact Me?

1. _____ your spiritual condition and make sure you are resting in His grace for salvation.
2. _____ in salvation given through Jesus. God's judgment against sin was cast upon Him so you could have forgiveness of sin. (Is. 53:4-6; 2 Cor. 5:21)
3. Examine your _____ as a Christian. Realize you have been entrusted with time, opportunities, resources, spiritual gifts, etc. Be faithful to His call upon your life.
4. _____ in His ability to judge equitably and correctly. We see injustice on earth but must rest in His actions to ultimately and correctly reconcile all things. (Rom. 12:19-21; Ps. 9:8; 98:9)
5. _____ that a just, holy, and sovereign God has delivered you by grace through faith in Jesus. His salvation is secure and eternal. Do not live in fear, doubt, and worry.
6. _____ the Gospel message. God's wrath is real, and His judgments are final.
7. Don't ignore God _____. We can sometimes emphasize God's love and fail to show His righteousness, justice, and wrath. The payment for our sin must be addressed and is only addressed through the blood of Jesus.
8. Realize there is no do-over nor is there purgatory. God's judgment occurs at the end of life for _____, and it is _____. (Heb. 9:27)
